MUSIC AT KOHL MANSION ANNOUNCES PROGRAM CHANGE
TRIO CON BRIO COPENHAGEN TO OPEN MUSIC AT KOHL SEASON OCT. 22
AMELIA PIANO TRIO WILL PERFORM IN KOHL SERIES FEB. 4
Two Music at Kohl Mansion Débuts Replace Cancelled Grieg and Paris Piano Trios

Burlingame, CA, September 11, 2006 – Music at Kohl Mansion announced today that the Trio Con Brio Copenhagen will open the 24th annual series of chamber concerts in Burlingame’s historic Kohl Mansion on Sunday, October 22nd, 2006 at 7 pm. The Trio con Brio replaces Norway’s Grieg Trio, whose U.S. tour was cancelled late last week due to irresolvable travel difficulties.

On Sunday, February 4, 2007 at 7 pm, the Amelia Piano Trio makes its Music at Kohl Mansion début, replacing the Paris Piano Trio, whose U.S. tour was rescheduled to a later time due to unexpected Festival date changes on their home turf in France.

Trio con Brio Copenhagen

Trio con Brio Copenhagen, formed in Vienna in 1999 by the Korean sisters Soo-Jin Hong and Soo-Kyung Hong and the Danish pianist Jens Elvekjaer, drew attention by the sensational success at the ARD-competition in Munich. In September 2005, the Trio con Brio Copenhagen received the prestigious Kalichstein-Laredo-Robinson International Trio Award in the United States. The award includes a CD-recording and an extensive tour of 20 major U.S. venues including Carnegie Hall.

Amelia Piano Trio

Formed in 1999, the Amelia Piano Trio (Anthea Kreston, violin, Jason Duckles, cello, and Rieko Aizawa, piano) has established a glowing international reputation. Called “remarkable” by *Strings* and “exemplary” by *The Strad*, the group has quickly become one of its generation’s most sought-after ensembles. The Trio has performed extensively in North America, France, Italy, Panama, and the Caribbean, and toured North America and Central Asia with Yo-Yo Ma’s Silk Road Project.

About Music at Kohl Mansion

Located just 15 miles south of San Francisco, the series has been a favorite of music lovers from as far away as San Jose, Marin County and East Bay communities for nearly a quarter-century. Housed in a beautiful 1912 Tudor-style estate in Burlingame, Music at Kohl is reputed among musicians as a favorite place to perform, both for its splendid acoustics and warm, enthusiastic audiences. Concert-goers cite the outstanding quality of artists and repertoire as the main reason they attend year after year. Many enthuse about the "Music at Kohl experience", distinguished by the beautiful venue, casual yet elegant ambiance, affordable tickets, friendly patrons and the complimentary post-concert receptions and conversations with musicians after every performance.
