**WHAT:** **MUSIC AT KOHL MANSION (MAKM)**, the Bay Area's "prestigious chamber music presenter" (*SF Chronicle*) hosts a special 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Season concert Sunday, November 13 at 7 p.m. distinguished by the **World Premiere** of Japanese-American composer **Shinji Eshima's** commissioned work, *Hymn for Her*. Program also includes selections from two previous commissioned works by Ernst Bacon and David Carlson, plus Felix Mendelssohn. A rare anniversary concert not to be missed.

**WHERE:** Burlingame's historic **Kohl Mansion, 2750 Adeline Drive**. Experience beautiful chamber music in the intimate and warm acoustic of the Mansion's Elizabethan-style Great Hall (1914) with limited seating capacity of 200. Free and ample parking on site.
