(August 15, 2024) — **Music at Kohl Mansion (MAKM)** today announced single tickets for the 2024-25 international chamber music season will go on sale today, Thursday, August 15 for all seven concerts featuring many of the world's leading classical music ensembles from the United States, Canada, France, Germany, Israel and Venezuela – including three in their house debut – showcasing the finest classical and contemporary music repertoire, a U.S. debut, and several Bay Area premieres.

Adding to the excitement of the 42nd season, the internationally acclaimed **San Francisco Girls Chorus Premier Ensemble**, along with Artistic Director and Conductor **Valérie Sainte-Agathe**, will make their first appearance at the historic Kohl Mansion with a memorable non-subscription Family Holiday concert on December 15. Tickets for this concert will also go on sale beginning August 15.

“I am delighted to announce the availability of single tickets for our upcoming concerts in addition to continuing to offer discounted subscription tickets to the 7-concert chamber music series,” said Executive Director **Patricia Kristof Moy**. “Due to the intimate size of Kohl Mansion’s Great Hall, which is ideal for chamber music as it was meant to be heard, many concerts last season were at capacity, with waiting lists for ticket

buyers. We urge the public to take this opportunity to secure their tickets now to hear some of the world's leading international ensembles. On behalf of Music at Kohl Mansion, we look forward to welcoming you."

The Music at Kohl Mansion subscription season will launch with the award-winning **Borromeo String Quartet**, Oct. 20; Canada's endlessly inventive **Gryphon Trio**, Nov. 24; the debut of the Venezuelan **Reverón Piano Trio**, Jan. 12; the anticipated premiere of **Trio Karénine** from Paris, Feb. 23; the debut of Germany's critically acclaimed **Aris Quartet**, March 16; the return of the distinguished **Ariel Quartet**, originally from Israel, April 13; and a farewell concert by the legendary **Alexander String Quartet** with guest pianist, **Jeffrey LaDeur**, May 4.

Beginning Thursday, August 15, single tickets go on sale for all seven chamber music concerts and are priced \$62 (adult), \$60 (senior) and \$30 (age 30 and under). Tickets for the San Francisco Girls Chorus Premier Ensemble Holiday Concert on December 15 are priced at \$40 (adult) and \$20 (age 18 and under). Subscription tickets for the 7-concert season are also available and range in price from \$370 (adult) and \$355 (senior) to \$175 (age 30 and under). All concerts are held on Sunday evenings at 7 p.m. and include a complimentary post-performance reception with the artists. Ample free parking is available for all ticket holders. Music at Kohl Mansion is located at 2750 Adeline Drive, Burlingame.

Christopher Costanza, renowned cellist with the recently disbanded St. Lawrence String Quartet and active Stanford educator/coach, will offer an informative pre-concert lecture for ticket holders at 6 p.m. in the Kohl Mansion Library before all seven subscription concerts; no pre-performance talk before the Dec. 15 program.
