Burlingame, CA (February 18, 2022) — Five distinguished chamber **Musicians from the San Francisco Symphony** will be presented by **Music at Kohl Mansion** in an intimate concert Sunday, March 6 at 7 p.m. in a program of rarely performed works by Gioachino Rossini, Antonin Dvořák and African-American composers Florence Price and Jessie Montgomery.

Appearing in the Great Hall of the historic Kohl Mansion will be San Francisco Symphony musicians **Jessie Fellows**, violin; **Matt Young**, viola; **Barbara Bogatin**, cello; **Polina Sedukh**, violin, replacing Wyatt Hill; and **Charles Chandler**, double bass, replacing Daniel Smith.

The curated program will open with Rossini's youthful Sonata No. 3 in C Major scored for violin, viola, cello and double bass; followed by Florence Price's *Five Folksongs in Counterpoint* ("Calvary," "Oh My Darlin' Clementine," "Drink to Me with Thine Eyes Only," "Shortin' Bread," and "Swing Low, Sweet

Chariot”) for string quartet; Jessie Montgomery’s contemporary work for string quintet, *Strum*; and concluding with Dvořák’s award-winning and joyful String Quintet in G Major, Op. 77.

Music at Kohl Mansion’s 39th anniversary season continues Sunday, April 10 at 7 p.m. with the award-winning French-Belgian ensemble, **Quatuor Danel**, performing Tchaikovsky’s String Quartet No. 3 in E-flat Minor, Op. 30 and César Franck’s String Quartet in D Major. The season concludes with the recently announced **American String Quartet** on Sunday, May 1 at 7 p.m., in an evening of musical works by Franz Joseph Haydn, Quartet in D Major, Op. 76, No. 5, *Largo*; Samuel Barber, Adagio from String Quartet, Op. 11; George Walker, Lament from String Quartet No. 1, *Lyric*; and Johannes Brahms, Quartet in A Minor, Op. 51, No. 2.

Music at Kohl Mansion continues its longstanding association with the San Mateo Public Library and will present “A Musical Conversation with Quatuor Danel” on Saturday, April 9, from 3 to 4 p.m. and “A Musical Conversation with the American String Quartet on Saturday, April 30, from 3 to 4 p.m. Both events are free to the public. The San Mateo Public Library is located at 55 West 3rd Avenue.

Single tickets for individual concerts are \$52 (General), \$49 (Senior) and \$22 (age 30 and under). To purchase tickets, visit www.musicatkohl.org or call Music at Kohl Mansion Box Office, (650) 762-1130.

Effective Sunday, March 6, all audience members will be asked to show proof of their full COVID-19 vaccination, including a booster shot, prior to entry to the live concert. In order to allow for social distancing, Music at Kohl management has reduced its indoor seating to a maximum of 60% of capacity. Convenient public hand sanitizing stations are provided.
